The Brixton Project works to create a cultural environment in our public places and spaces, where children and young people can recognise themselves and their heritage as a significant factor in unlocking their agency in the progress of cultural decolonisation. BXP will support teachers' through equipping them with the skills and confidence to effectively teach and discuss diverse narratives in the classroom.

They want to:

- Expand the capacity to talk, enquire, raise curiosity, improve confidence, openness and broaden perceptions using creativity and culture as a basis and engage the group in the social narrative of decolonisation locally, nationally, globally (such as the current Culture Wars debate).
- Help young people feel more inspired and represented in the cultural sector.
- Ensure teachers, CYP and Lambeth's wider community are culturally better connected and have access to community organisations and events that champion diversity and creativity.
- Allow for professionals in the culture sector to have a contact and space where they can signpost the community to their work.
- Improve engagement with priority groups of young people including those who are care experienced; deaf, disabled & neurodiverse; under 5, 16-18 Portuguese speaking.

Oxygen is currently leading the Black British Ballet project, which aims to address the historic underrepresentation of black dancers in British ballet. As a social enterprise, profits are invested into digital arts training for young people of the global majority in London and abroad. Oxygen want to connect young people across the 'Black Atlantic' to create digital art that explores the issues that impact their lives, enables them to speak truth to power and gives them an opportunity of a career in the industry.

Oxygen want to:

- Encourage more children and young people to engage in Lambeth's cultural offer and to better understand the barriers to participation.
- Link this local data to wider evidence around the positive impact of arts participation on health and wellbeing and educational attainment.
